

We are delighted to welcome you to Golf at Piperdam. We have been working hard to give you the best experience on our 18-hole and 9-hole golf courses. Due to the Covid-19 situation we have implemented some extra measures to safeguard both yourself and staff when at Piperdam and ask all guests to adhere to these compulsory procedures.

#### Continue to follow government guidelines on COVID-19

- Self-Isolating- If you have symptoms or have been in contact with anybody with COVID-19 symptoms you are not permitted to visit the Golf Club until you have completed your period of quarantine.
- Social Distancing
- Wash your hands regularly with soap and water
- Visit Scottish Government website for all the latest updates

#### **Booking tee times**

- Tee-times should be ideally booked in advance.
- Please contact the Pro Shop on 01382 585012 to book your tee time for both the 18-hole and 9-hole golf course.

#### **Procedures for golfers**

The following procedures, which have been established to ensure a safe environment for all golfers and all on-site staff, set out the basis on how golfers can return to the fairways in a safe environment as outlined by the Scottish Government's Phase 2 relaxation of restrictions. Not only are Golfers expected to comply with the rules they must also observe the government and public health restrictions.

#### To ensure the safe return to golf at Piperdam, golfers should adhere to these guidelines:

- If you are in the highest risk (shielding) group outlined by the Government, then you follow latest guidance.
- If you are ill or have any symptoms of COVID- 19 then stay at home.
- Under no circumstances should you arrive at the club without booking in advance.
- You should not exchange equipment with other members.
- Aim to arrive at the Courses no more than 15 minutes prior to play.
- Park your car in such a way as to facilitate physical distancing.
- Change your shoes in the car park.
- The putting and chipping green will be open for use prior to your round but please do not congregate at these areas.
- The Changing rooms, lockers and toilets are now open.

#### On the course

- Do not arrive at the first tee more than 5 minutes before your allotted tee time.
- Always observe social distancing rules on the course.
- With no rakes allowed on the course, golfers to make their very best efforts to smooth the sand using their club and/or their feet.

### Important Golf and Covid-19 Guidelines Continued Please read carefully

- Following play of a hole, do not enter the next teeing area until the all members of the group in front have played their tee-shots and exited the teeing area.
- Do not share equipment, food or drink with other players during your round.
- Do not touch the flag or flagstick. Putt with the flagstick in and remove your own ball from the hole. Remember not every putt needs to be holed out in casual golf.
- Toilets are available in the entrance to the Pro Shop.
- Most of the on-course furniture including Benches, Bins, Ball washers and Bunker rakes have been removed around the course as per Government recommendations.
- Please DO NOT touch or remove the Flags at any time. The pins have been modified to stop the ball dropping down the hole.
- Do not retrieve found golf balls from anywhere around the course.

### After your round

• On completing your round, please head straight to your cars or lodge and do not congregate in any areas or wait for others to finish their rounds.

These restrictions will not remain forever but while they are in place, please respect them. We thank you in advance for following the series of guidelines above. Golf courses would not have been allowed to re-open without such measures being in place.

Turn right onto North Lindsay Street. Follow the road round until you reach the Overgate car park

### Our Cleaning Measures During COVID-19

We understand that we are still living in very strange times and that you may have questions regarding what we are doing at Piperdam to ensure safer stays for all our guests, so please find below additional information to alleviate any concerns.

### Q: How do I know that my lodge holiday will be safe and clean?

A: We will be providing our Hygiene Safe Assurance (see details below) prior to access been given to your accommodation.

#### Q: What is your Hygiene Safe Assurance (HSA)?

A: Our teams have now been trained in an extended cleaning regime for all accommodation, which is carried out prior to each guest's arrival. A 3-stage process has now been adopted:

- 1. Sanitise the whole lodge and hot tub (where applicable)
- 2. Anti-bacterial clean of the key touch points such as kitchen appliances, surfaces, door handles, light switches and TV remotes.
- 3. Steam clean on key surfaces, touch points and bathroom surfaces.

It is only after all three stages have been completed and checked, will the lodge be given our HSA.

#### Q: What will I need to bring with me?

A: Our Parks are self-catering with towels and bed linen provided. We do provide a Welcome Pack, subject to availability, with some basic provisions but you are encouraged to bring your own food and supplies as you require.

#### Q: What is the check in procedure?

A: Your check in time will be **4pm** – this later check in time is to ensure our HSA has been completed. The check in will take place in our reception where we have social distancing markers laid out. We ask that only one person from your party (this must be the lead name on the booking) comes into reception for the check in, so that we can keep numbers to a minimum.

### Q: What is the check-out procedure?

A: Your check out time is no later than 9:30am. If you are leaving us before **9.30am** then you can post your key in our outside key-drop post-box by the main building entrance.

### How to Lift the Hot Tub Cover

Please follow these instructions carefully





Step 1 Lift one side of the cover

Step 2 Fold cover over the bar

Step 3 Pull the cover and lift off the hot tub as per the image above

Step 4 The cover is then supported by the metal bar at the side of the hot tub

### Hot Tub Use Important - Please read carefully

Your Health and Safety is of paramount importance to us and for this reason a member of our Spa Team will visit your lodge on a daily basis between the hours of 08.00 and 16:00 to test and adjust your Hot Tub as required. You are not required to be available as access to the hot tub will be gained externally. Should you have any concerns about the water quality in your Hot Tub please contact Reception (01382) 585000 (opt. 0)

We will endeavour to have your Hot Tub at an optimum temperature on the day of your arrival. At times this may not be possible due to maintenance, cleaning and fresh water being required before you arrive. Each morning your hot tub will be checked and chemically tested however it will not be refilled if there has been evidence of excessive misuse. The water levels will diminish if the Hot Tub is used by too many people at any one time. The Hot Tubs are only adequate for 2-6 people at any one time. Please do not touch the mode button on the Hot Tub as you will alter the settings which can reduce the temperature.

Remember, please use the hot tub responsibly and always put the lid back on after you have finished using it.

### **Prevent Drowning**

Heat will speed up the effects of alcohol, drugs or medicine and can cause unconsciousness. Immediately leave the hot tub if you feel uncomfortable or sleepy.

Guests are asked to shower before entering the hot tub.

Good Hot Tub hygiene is important for the health and comfort of all users, hence;

- No hot tub use after 11pm
- It is recommended guests remove jewellery, lotions and fake tan before entering the tub
- Children under 16 years of age are not permitted to use the hot tub
- Bathers should be discouraged from swallowing the hot tub water
- It is recommended that bathers do not exceed 15 minutes immersion at a time
- Maximum Bather Numbers: Eagle, Forester, Galbraith, Lochside and Vegas Lodges (6 Bathers); Raeburn, Byron, Osprey and Rainbow Lodges (4 Bathers); Muirloch and Byron Lodges (2 Bathers)
- It is recommended that the hot tub is not used after a heavy meal or while under the influence of alcohol or sedatives
- If 'intended users' are suffering from diseases of the heart and circulation, skin conditions, suppressed immune symptoms or are subject to fits, take drugs or medication that affect the cardiovascular or nervous system, they should seek medical advice before bathing in a hot tub.
- Pregnant women are advised to consult with their doctor before using the hot tub.
- No glass or sharp objects permitted in the Hot Tub or surrounding area. Please use plastic cups provided in your lodge.
- Your hot tub temperature is set at approximately 38°c. Guests are requested to only use the light and jet keys on the control pad.
   Use of other keys, may put the tub into sleep or economy mode resulting in much lower temperatures. This may prevent the use of your hot tub.
- Use the steps provided to enter and exit the hot tub.
- Please ensure that at all times adequate footwear is worn prior to entering and exiting the hot tub area. Guests are advised to towel dry prior to entering the lodge to avoid slipping.

### Sauna Use Important - Please read carefully

### **General Guidance**

- Switch the sauna on and set temperature. Most saunas have 2 dials; the first dial is the ON/TIMER dial. You should set this to between numbers 1-4 and your sauna will stay on for 1-4 hours. The second group of numbers on this dial is a timer delay and your sauna will not come on until 1-8 hours later. This should be done approx. 30 minutes before use. If you decide to increase the temperature this should be done by sprinkling a small amount of water over the coals using the ladle provided, the water must then be given time to evaporate. Failure to allow the water time to evaporate will cause irreparable damage to the element.
- Avoid contact with heating element at all times.

### Guests should NOT use the sauna if they:

- Are under 16 years of age
- Are pregnant
- Suffer from existing medical conditions such as heart disease, circulatory problems, high or low blood pressure, kidney disease or any condition which may have a reaction to heat.
- Are suffering from an infectious skin disease, sores or wounds.
- Have consumed a heavy meal within 2 hours.
- Have consumed alcohol within 4 hours.
- Suffer from migraines.
- Have recently exercised please allow sufficient time to enable body temperature to return to normal level.

### Departure

You are more than welcome to use the facilities within the resort on the day of your departure however you must vacate your lodge by **9:30am**. Failure to do so may incur an additional charge, Lodge keys must be returned to Reception. If you lose a key, you will be charged £35 for each key. If you find the key and return it you will be reimbursed.

### Security Deposit

A security deposit will be pre-authorised on your arrival. This is not held by Piperdam. The funds should be available to you and if not, you should check with your bank. If you have been charged in any way for damage you will always be informed about this. Should there be substantial damage of any sort we will contact you before we redeem any monies from your security deposit.

- £150 (all other lodges)

### Lost Property

Please check thoroughly that you haven't left anything behind. We take no responsibility for any item left behind. We will only keep Lost Property items onsite for 7 days maximum and then they will be disposed of thereafter. Any item left behind must be uplifted within 10 days. We are willing to post items when requested within 7 days at a £10.00 minimum charge.

### Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in any of the lodges.

### **General Guidance**

#### What time is check-in and check-out?

Key collection is currently **4pm** to allow for additional cleaning requirements however guests can head to main reception earlier to complete your pre-registration check in which will speed up your key collection time significantly. Please note that you will be unable to access your lodge before **4pm**. Check out is by **9:30am** on your day of departure.

#### Is there a hairdryer?

Yes, there is a hairdryer in every lodge. You will find this in the master bedroom.

#### Is there a washing machine?

Yes, and either a tumble dryer or a washer dryer, this excludes the Byron Lodges.

#### What does the welcome pack consist of?

Dishwasher tablets, bin bags, cloths and a sponge.

### Are there irons in the lodges?

Yes, there is an iron and ironing board provided in the lodge.

### Do we need to book the golf?

Booking is required. You can book on arrival or phone in advance to do this on 01382 585000.

### Where is the nearest shop/supermarket?

We have an onsite Shop for all those last-minute amenities. The local villages of Muirhead & Birkhill also have a couple of shops which will have all main necessities. If you need a bigger shop there is a Tesco Extra and Asda details of which are included in this welcome pack.

### Do supermarkets deliver to the lodges?

Most of the main supermarkets (Tesco & Asda) deliver shopping straight to your lodge. Please ensure the delivery time slot is after 4pm when your lodge is ready.

#### Is there Wi-Fi?

There is Wi-Fi within the main resort and Lochside Lodges. This is free of charge. All other lodges currently do not have Wi-Fi.

### Do I need the card used for the security deposit at check out?

No, as we don't refund the card, the amount is released automatically. You won't see it on your statements as a sale or a refund.

### Are BBQs allowed on park?

BBQs are not permitted on site within the woodland lodges. We only permit BBQs at our Lochside Premier lodges.

#### Do you have a Lost Child Policy?

If your child is lost, please notify Reception immediately.

### Can you park at the lodge?

Yes. We have parking at the lodge however the number of cars is restricted for emergency access purposes. Any additional cars must park in the main secure car park located at the main resort. We permit the following at the lodges:

- \* Muirloch Lodges; Byron Lodges 1 car
- \* Rainbow/Spa/Spa Plus Lodges; Barnard/Spa Lodges; Raeburn Lodge 1 car
- \* Osprey/Spa Lodges; Galbraith Lodges 2 cars
- \* Vegas Spa Plus; Eagle Spa Plus; Forester Spa Plus; Kinder Lodge, Lochside Lodges 3 cars
