This is a low-level walk in the Sidlaw Hills to the north of Dundee. It begins and ends on farm roads, but most of the route is on tracks over open grass and heather, generally easy walking with two short, steep climbs over grass. There are superb views over the Angus Glens to the north and the Tay Estuary to the South.
